



Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Rajamangala University of Technology
Phra Nakhon
and



Chiang Rai Aviation Holding Company Limited
On Academic and Aviation Collaboration

This memorandum of understanding ("MOU") is made on 10th September 2019. This MOU expresses the cooperation between **Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon ("RMUTP")**, located at 399 Samsen Road, Vajira Payaban, Dusit, Bangkok 10300, Kingdom of Thailand as authorised by Associate Professor Supatra Kosaiyakanont, the Acting President, and **Chiang Rai Aviation Holding Company Limited ("CAH")**, located at 89 Prasopsook Road, Wiang, Mueang Chiang Rai District, Chiang Rai 57000 Thailand as authorised by Ms. Paradee Chongsuktanamanee, the Managing Director .

RMUTP and CAH, hereinafter referred to as the "Parties", have agreed to promote academic and aviation collaboration. The Parties have reached the agreement as follows:

1. The Parties shall encourage, promote, and implement the following activities:

Academic and Aviation Aspects

- 1.1 Develop pilot, aircraft maintenance, and aviation ground support programs and learning processes;
- 1.2 Develop curriculum and organize field trips and workshops to promote knowledge sharing and learning among academic staff and students;
- 1.3 Participate in seminars, academic meetings, symposiums and lectures;
- 1.4 Expand on students' learning and co-operative education (co-op) opportunities;
- 1.5 Enroll students and alumni who wish to increase their academic qualifications in new collaborative programs and courses; and
- 1.6 Provide scholarships and grants to faculties, students, and alumni who wish to increase their academic qualifications through further study in new collaborative programs and courses.

Other Aspects

- 1.7 Provide resources for technology transfers and academic services; and
- 1.8 Exchange of academic materials and other relevant information.

2. This MOU expresses the intention of the Parties. It is acknowledged by both Parties that the MOU does not have legal effect, nor does it contain financial or operational requirements that are legally binding on either Party. Specific agreements or other memorandums of understanding necessary for implementing this MOU shall be made separately following negotiation and agreement between the Parties.
3. This MOU shall take effect from the date that representatives of the Parties affix their signatures to it ("effective date"). This MOU shall be valid for a term of five years from the effective date, and the term may be revised or extended by mutual consent of the Parties.
4. Either party may terminate the MOU at any time by written notice signed by an appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. The notice must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination. The termination of this MOU will not affect the continued implementation of on-going activities or programs undertaken pursuant to this MOU that were initiated prior to the date of termination of this MOU, unless as otherwise jointly agreed upon by the Parties.
5. This MOU shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws and regulation of the Kingdom of Thailand. Further, all activities resulting from this MOU shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws and regulations of the Kingdom of Thailand. All agreements and obligations of the Parties shall be subject to the procurement and maintenance of all applicable government consents, permits, authorizations, and approvals.
6. Any dispute or differences arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation between the Parties.
7. All information shared, permissions granted, and agreements made under this MOU shall be communicated in writing by an official letter to the other party.
8. This MOU is made in two identical counterpart copies, each of which is to be considered the original.
