

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

**Faculty of Science and Technology, Rajamangala University of Technology
Phra Nakhon, Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and
Innovation, Thailand**

(Hereinafter referred to as “First Party”)

And

World Ayush Foundation & Maalyarth Foundation , India

(Hereinafter referred to as “Second Party”)

Faculty of Science and Technology, Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation, Thailand (each referred to herein individually as a “Party” and World Ayush Foundation & Maalyarth Foundation India and collectively as the “Parties”) wish to strengthen and further develop cooperation between the Parties to study traditional systems of medicine, and have agreed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to set up the Collaboration in the field of Ayurveda;

The purpose of MOU is to promote a mutual cooperation in education, research and skill development in the field of Ayurveda and to conduct activities there of an establish a framework for programs of exchange and collaboration in area of innovation, internship work, integrated learning with respect to promoting ayurveda globally for mutual benefits.

The MOU would be applicable on mutual convenient and acceptable terms and conditions of corporation.

1. SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

The scope of the parties’ activities may include:

- 1.1 Undertaking academic activities in the field of Ayurveda in collaboration with the identified institutions.
- 1.2 Collaborating on research, including study design and execution.
- 1.3 Disseminating results of completed studies with associated medical professionals of both the organizations.
- 1.4 Developing evidence-based guidelines for integrating Ayurvedic principles and practices with modern medicine with the experts of both the organization.

- 1.5 Conducting lectures, workshops, seminars, and/or conferences and other such activities on Ayurveda.
- 1.6 Developing academic standards and courses in accordance with the needs of the institution, end users and stakeholders and develop Ayurvedic medical education guidelines for Ayurveda education in Thailand.
- 1.8 Seeking continuous improvement in curriculum development.
- 1.9 Acting as credible source of Ayurveda-related information in Thailand.
- 1.10 Utilizing and, when necessary, exchanging faculty, fellows, post-graduate/doctoral trainees, and clinical staff as determined by the parties on a project-to-project basis after mutual agreed terms and conditions separately.
- 1.11 Cooperate and collaborate to achieve excellence in Ayurveda supported with scientific advances, tools and techniques.
- 1.12 Abiding to the terms and conditions of this Collaboration to the extent that they do not come into conflict with each Parties' internal policies.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective Authorities, have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.

Signed at 17 December 2022 in two (2) originals, each in the English and Hindi languages, all texts being equally authentic that both parties thoroughly read, understand, and agree on all the purposes. Therefore, both parties sign and stamp (if any) it for further reference. In case of divergence of interpretation, the English text shall prevail.


